Can You Be The FOSTER GRANDPARENT A Child Needs?

Eligibility to become a Foster Grandparent:

- Enjoy working with children
- Alachua County Resident
- Persons age 55+
- Meet established income guidelines
- Pass a Level II Background Screening
- Be in reasonably good physical and mental health
- Complete 40 hours of pre-service training
- Able to serve a desired minimum of 5 hours per week

BENEFITS FOR FGP VOLUNTEERS

- Be a part of a supportive team that witnesses improvements and success in children
- Receive a non-taxable stipend payment of \$3.00 an hour
- Transportation provided or reimbursed for mileage
- Daily meal provided by host site.
- Have opportunities to meet new people and enhance socialization.
