Creating your Post

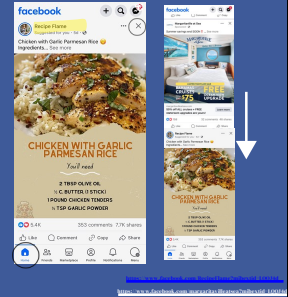
- After clicking "What's on your mind" you can edit the text
- "Photo/Video" to pick pictures or videos saved on that device
- "Tag people" is how you can let others know that you posted about them and anyone who sees your post will be able to see the tagged person's account
- "Check in" is how you let your friends know where you are by posting your location

Viewing Posts

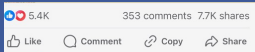
- Click the house icon that says "Home"
- Scroll down to see multiple posts from others
- The highlighted bolded text that states "Recipe Flame" is the name of the account
- This post is an advertisement, this is evident due to the X in the right hand corner

How to Interact

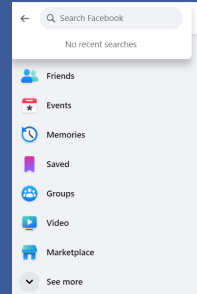
- Thumbs up icon that says "Like" is a way of showing the person who posted it that you appreciate what they shared
- The word bubble icon that says "Comment" is how you can share your thoughts about a post
- "Copy" with the paperclip icon is for sharing the website link to this exact post.
- "Share" with the arrow icon gives you the option to share it on your page, in a group, with specific friends, or to open in a different app

How to find Family/Friends

- In the top left search bar, type in the name of the person you want to connect with

- You can see your friends/requests by clicking on the friend tab that is also pictured



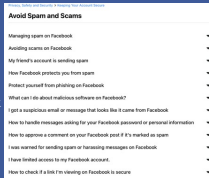

On a computer:

- Locate your profile icon in the top right. Click "Help & Support" -> click "Help Center"

On a tablet:

Three Rules to Protect Yourself

SLOW DOWN

Scammers often try to create a sense of urgency or threaten you with losing your account or other action. Take time to ask questions and think it through.

SPOT CHECK

Scammers often mention a problem to encourage you to act. Do your research to double check the details before clicking links or downloading files. Does what they're telling you make sense?

DON'T SEND

Scammers often pretend to be from a familiar organization, they may use its employee photo they stole from the internet to convince you. No reputable organization will demand payment on the spot.
