



NEW RESEARCH STUDY WITH ADULT CHILD AND SPOUSAL DEMENTIA CAREGIVERS

The University of Florida is seeking adult child and spousal caregivers of people living with dementia, such as Alzheimer disease, Lewy body dementia, stroke-related dementia, or frontotemporal dementia, to participate in an interview about their caregiving experiences and support needs. - Adults who 1) are caring for a parent or spouse diagnosed with dementia within the last 3 years, 2) reside in Florida, and 3) are English-speaking.
